Employment Services

The pandemic certainly impacted all services provided by Opportunities Unlimited; our Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) experienced a sharp decline when many of these services were suspended. This past year we've been excited to re-open and expand these programs. One of our HCBS programs is Employment Services. Employment Services provides a number of services including programs with the local schools, Iowa Vocational Rehab (IVRS), and Supported Employment (SE). SE alone has hired three new job coaches since September to fulfill the needs of those who are working in the community setting. Job Coaches are the difference makers. If they hear the phrase "I'll never get this done," it is replaced

with "You've done it before, and You can do it again." We must remember that a journey of a thousand miles begins with a single step and one person can make a difference. Our OU Job Coaches are supporting several individuals in the community who take pride in their jobs and are working in a variety of local businesses including restaurants, retail, lawn service, grocery, and hospitality. It's wonderful to experience the pride our persons served have in working and the positive support they often have from their co-workers and community.

Opportunities Unlimited continues to bring awareness of brain injuries to our community and has been promoting brain injury awarenss through varous initiatives. Our original program, "Gotta Brain Getta Helmet" is shared with second grade students throughout our community. By partnering with local educators, OU is able to provide valuable brain injury prevention curriculum that highlights the importance of bicycle safety and wearing protective equipment. Participating students create essays or posters to capture what they've learned from the program. With the support of Vern Eide, OU was able to provide nearly 1700 helmets to students this year! It has been rewarding to be able to promote



safety and brain injury prevention to students who eagerly take part in HYUNDAI this initiative!






